This cause came before this Court for a hearing on a Petition of Dissolution of Marriage. The Court having reviewed the file and heard the testimony makes these findings of fact and reaches these conclusions of law.

1. The court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter and the parties.
2. At least one party has been a resident of the state of OKLAHOMA for more than 6 months immediately before filing the Petition of Dissolution of Marriage.
3. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken, therefore, the marriage between the parties is dissolved and the parties are restored to the status of being single.
